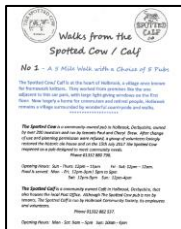
Produce Competition

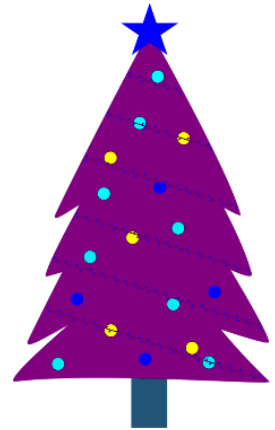
